



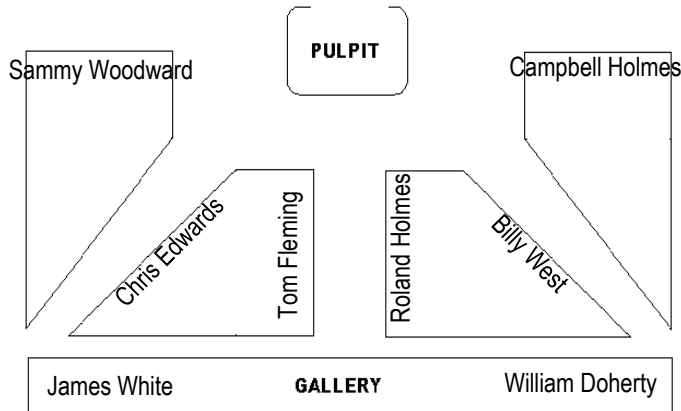

NOW LET US WORSHIP THE KING OF KINGS!

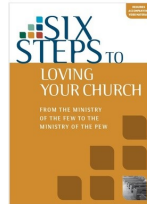
