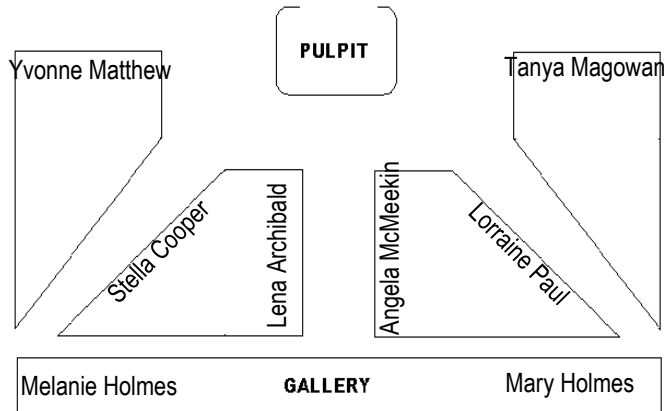
If you need any sort of help today, please do not hesitate to wait and speak to the minister afterwards or contact him at home.
